

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES


❖ General Requirements

- ✓ you can send more than one abstract for presentation in an event.
- ✓ Accepted abstracts can be presented as either oral or poster.
- ✓ The abstract can be sent via email to Conference@aeirc-edu.com as well as via online submission on the our [Web page](#).
- ✓ Presentation of Abstract for oral must be carried by the presenting author on the day of the event as well as a copy shall also be sent as an email to Conference@aeirc-edu.com.
- ✓ Posters of Abstract must be carried by the presenting author on the day of the event.

❖ Abstract Format Guidelines:

Please follow the below-mentioned guidance to format your abstract.

1. **Title:** A complete title which must represent the objective of the study, Bold and use capital letters ONLY where necessary. DO NOT underline or use italics unless necessary
2. **Author Block:** Provide an adequate sequence of the authors, a Steric (*) for presenting author and full contact details of a Corresponding author. DO NOT provide designation along with authors' names. DO NOT mention more than 3 affiliations of an author.
3. **Abstract Body:** Word count of an abstract MUST NOT exceed more than 250-300 words. The only structured abstract is accepted, there should be following headlines in an abstract body:
 - ✓ Background/Introduction
 - ✓ Objectives/Purpose of the Study
 - ✓ Methodology
 - ✓ Results
 - ✓ Conclusion

- ❖ Confidential peer-review will determine the selection of the Oral/Posters. Acceptance will be communicated via e-mail only.
 - ❖ The Abstract Committee reserves the rights to select your abstract for Oral/Poster presentation as deemed appropriate. However, you can mark the preference.
 - ❖ Abstracts accepted for presentation at the conference will be published in Conference Proceedings (online & printed).
 - ❖ Submission will only be accepted after event registration
